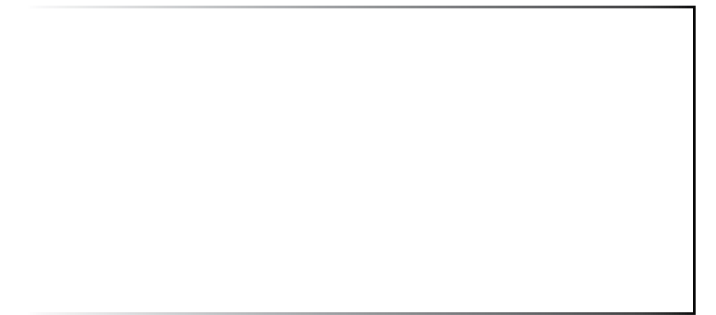


Figure 2: Tympanum, Autun, France, 1130.
