Because hazing activity is intended to

can be difficult to investigate. Reports of hazing can be made anonymously; however, it is very important to be specific about <u>who</u> is involved, <u>what</u> was observed, <u>when</u> and <u>where</u> the incident occurred relevant and specific information.
